

What cleaning products to use?

Criteria and background:

This list was compiled with information from a Facebook post requesting details of pre-COVID 19 cleaning products used by Australian therapists.

This list is by no means a definitive list of products that may be used and I am nor endorsing ANY of these products.

When researching these products, they were:

- checked against the Australian Therapeutic Goods Register (link below). Products making claims to be “hospital grade” must be on this list.
- Testing and efficacy for COVID 19 (available on product websites)
- Verification where possible on the EPA list for approved COVID 19 products.

Please note, to date I do not have any information as to what the use of these chemicals will do to your treatment table covers. I have reached out to some of the manufacturers for advice and will update with info when I hear back from them.

If you are aware of any other products that fit the criteria, please let me know and I am happy to add them to the list.
