

CONTRACTOR COMPLIANCE CHECKLIST

If you are engaged as a true contractor, you are responsible for all of your own policies and procedures as well as ensuring you display the appropriate documents in your clinic space.

The National Code applicable for your state.
Infection Control Policy and Procedure
Privacy Policy and Procedure
Complaints procedure
Refund/cancellation procedure
Insurance
Qualifications
Association Membership
A written contractor agreement
Appropriate clinic facility
If you share a client management system (eg at a multi modality clinic you should also have:
A written agreement to access client records should you leave
The written consent of the clients to share information between contactors at the clinic.
A written agreement to outline who is repsonsible for maintaining client records should the clinic close.

Even if you are a contractor, it is highly likely the business owner will still be required to pay your superannuation contribution.
